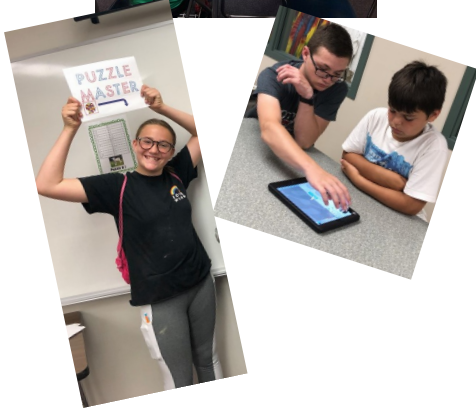
HMS BEFORE SCHOOL PROGRAM:
